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Rental Guidelines

All orders are bound to the Artery Props rental agreement (Rental Agreement), which carries a thorough set of guidelines for the usage of the material goods (the Equipment) and its inherent intellectual property (Licensed Material), as outlined here:

- 1. **Returns.** All rented Equipment, including customized items, must be returned except for the following products with the applied conditions:
 - a. Stickers that have been adhered to a surface.
 - b. Flyers that have been distressed, and the integrity of paper has become compromised.
 - c. Products prearranged to be destroyed, as noted on the invoice.

All unused Equipment must be returned. No Equipment can be kept on a kit or re-used.

- 2. Access. The Equipment shall be accessed and used only by Company's employees or agents qualified to use such Equipment for the production to which the Rental Agreement is bound, for the duration as listed on the rental invoice, and no other production, outside or within Company's jurisdiction, shall have access or use of the Equipment.
- **3. Manner of Usage.** The Equipment is to be used in a supplementary manner and can be neither the predominant element of the production, nor of any advertisements, promotion, publicity or other material relating to the production.
- **4. Stock Footage.** The Equipment may not be used in the production of stock footage.
- 5. Digital Scanning and Alteration. Company will not digitally scan the Equipment, or make digital alterations to the Licensed Material, including color, text or dimension changes, exclusive of the entirety of scenes photographed or recorded in connection to the production.
- **6. Physical Duplication.** Only Flyers, and no other Equipment, may be physically duplicated as required for the production. All duplications are subject to the terms in the Rental Agreement.
